CONTACT LENS EVALUATION POLICY

At **Visual Eyes** we aim to provide you with the best possible contact lenses for your needs. Insurance companies may only cover the cost of your eye examination, which includes updating your eyeglass prescription, cataract evaluation, determining your eye pressure for glaucoma, and examination of the external and internal health of the eyes. However, most insurers do <u>not</u> cover contact lens evaluation costs, since it requires extra time, evaluation and skill.

Your contact lens prescription is **not** the same as your eyeglass prescription. The proper size, curvature, lens power, and material are things considered when determining the right contact lens for you-- which may take several visits to finalize. This is what the contact lens evaluation covers. The cost of your contact lens evaluation is based on complexity (astigmatism, rigid gas permeable or multifocal contact lenses, for example) and time predicted for your specific case. The fee varies from \$110 and up for new wearers.

This cost includes:

- Evaluation for contact lenses
- Corneal topography for new wearers
- Training for new wearers, if necessary
- Starter kit of contact lens solution
- Any contact lens follow-up appointments within one year
- Access to our discounted contact lens materials
